

Cortland County Board of Realtors® Community Hero Award

HERO: A person who is admired or idealized for courage, outstanding achievements, or noble qualities.

The Cortland County Board of Realtors® Hero Award was developed to honor those who are making significant contributions through their time, actions, talents, and dedication to the Cortland Community. One candidate will be awarded per year.

Criteria:

The nominee consistently shows, models, and demonstrates qualities of compassion and service to either one organization or a variety of volunteer activities. The charitable activities or events cannot be part of a job description or job duties, no monetary benefit can be obtained. The nominee should have a passion and desire to help others and strive to make Cortland County a better community. Nominee must be a non-Realtor and reside within Cortland County.

Nominations:

Nominations may be made by any community member.

Procedure:

1. Each community member may nominate one individual.
2. The nominator shall complete the form provided. Photos, resumes, newspaper articles, etc. may be submitted as supporting documentation, however, nominator must describe in their own words why they feel this person is a Hero.
3. The nominator shall submit an original, signed application.
4. The CCBR Community Outreach Committee will review each nomination and make its recommendation to the Board of Directors at a regular meeting before January.
5. Upon approval of the CCBR Board of Directors, the honoree will be presented with an award at the CCBR Awards Ceremony, a donation to their charity of choice will be made.
6. Nominators may re-nominate unsuccessful candidates in subsequent years, however, applications will not be held over.

Presentation:

The award recipient will be honored during the CCBR Awards Ceremony in January.

- Award winner will be presented with an inscribed plaque or desk award
- An article will be published in the Cortland Standard
- A monetary donation of \$250 will be given to the Charity or Organization of the award recipient's choice in their honor
