The Cortland County Board of Realtors® Community Hero Award honors a person who recognizes their responsibility to their community and possesses a selfless dedication to the betterment of others and the betterment of our community.

The nominee must exemplify the spirit of community service and contribute to the community through volunteer service to one or a variety of organizations. They must serve as role models, inspire others to volunteer, and strive to make the Cortland area a better community. They must receive no financial compensation for their volunteer activities. Nominee must be a non-Realtor and a local resident.

Nominations may be made by a community member or Realtor.

- Each person may nominate one individual.
- Complete and sign the nomination form. You may attach photos, newspaper articles, etc., however, nominator must describe in their own words why they feel this person is a Hero.
- The CCBR Community Outreach Committee will review the nominations and make a recommendation to the Board of Directors before the Awards Luncheon.
- Unsuccessful candidates may be re-nominated in subsequent years by submitting a new application.

The award recipient will be honored during the CCBR Awards Ceremony in January. They will receive an inscribed plaque, a \$250 donation will be made to the organization of their choice, and they will be recognized in the Cortland Standard and at cortlandmls.com.
